Why is "Tony" there? To kill the venerable Frankie? To work for him? The mobster's bombshell wife, Sharon, has her own theories. Hilarious antics designed to divine Tony's purpose end with the discovery that he is a soap opera star signed to play Frankie in a feature film! Frankie detests movies and determines to have his guest fitted for cement shoes, but he warms to the idea of being glorified in a Hollywood epic. Laughs abound as he coaches Tony on how to play him.

Dan Beard is a resident of West Sacramento, and has been performing in the Sacramento and Bay Area for the last 7 years. Some of his favorite roles include Teddy Brewster, from *Arsenic and Old Lace*, Freddy the Bartender in *Picasso at the Lapin Agile* for the stage, and Det. Growing up in the small town of Lathrop, CA was not easy for upcoming actor Daniel O'Dea. Rounding out the ensemble is Vanessa Voetsch, who performed her first lead role of Emily in her school's production of *Our Town*. Now, with the support of her husband and family, she has returned to the stage to enjoy the challenge of becoming Sharon and providing entertainment for others.
